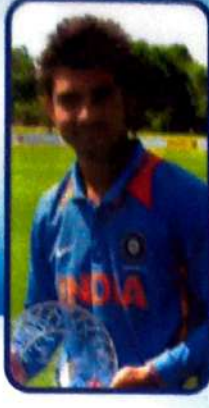

### Enabling Unit Report 2020-22

Swami Shraddhanand College established an Enabling Unit in the year 2009 for physically and visually impaired teachers and students. As per the guidelines of the 12th plan laid down by the University Grants Commission, the Unit must help the college in constructing an accessible infrastructure and provide useful study materials to visually challenged students in an accessible format.

During the lockdown period, the Unit members played an active role in helping students financially in May and June 2020 to help them attend online classes. A webinar was organized in March 2021 to sensitize disability-related issues during this period. The Unit recommended the names of 10 visually challenged students for the National Scholarship which is provided to the visually challenged students of the university by a non-government organization named “Help

the Blind Foundation”. In January 2022, the Unit recommended the name of Mr Surendra Kumar, a BA (Hons) Hindi student for the Vice-Chancellor's Gold Medal Scheme for visually challenged students.

In the same month, the Unit submitted a proposal to the college regarding setting up a computer lab in the new campus equipped with three brand new computers fitted with the latest version of JAWS software. Besides this, the Unit has also ordered the purchase of 5 digital audio recorders for the newly admitted students in the college. Apart from all the activities mentioned above, the members of Enabling Unit are pretty active during the admission process to facilitate the admission of physically and visually challenged students. Often, the Unit has arranged readers for the average academic activities and writers during the examination time for Visually Challenged students. The students have also been encouraged from time to time to participate in various extracurricular activities held in the college and other colleges of the University. The Unit has also worked carefully in preparing the roster of teaching and non-teaching vacancies of the college and has ensured its proper implementation.

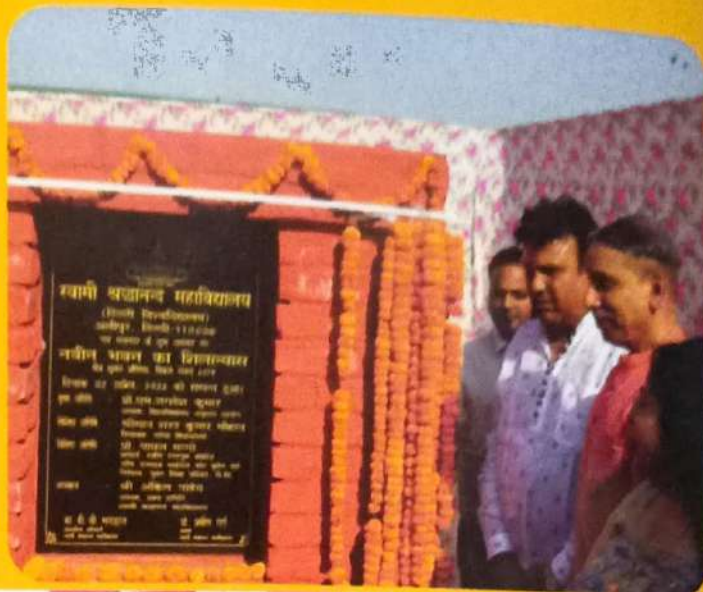
