

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME

1. The NSS Unit of Swami Shraddhanand College, along with NYKS, joined the launch of Amrit Kalash Yatra on September 1st, 2023 in New Delhi. The event featured Home Affairs Minister Amit Shah, Youth Affairs Minister Anurag Thakur, and other dignitaries. The yatra carries soil and saplings from across India to create an 'Amrit Vatika' near the National War Memorial, symbolizing unity and progress. The program included cultural performances and speeches highlighting national unity and tribute to freedom fighters.
2. Organised a seminar during National Eye Donation Fortnight, in coordination with Saksham Yuva Ayam, focusing on the theme "नेत्रदान, एक महादानः भ्रान्तिया एवं सच्चाई" This annual event, observed from August 25th to September 8th Nationwide, aims to raise awareness about eye donation and dispel myths surrounding it.
3. "Meri Maati Mera Desh" celebrates India's soil and heroism, fostering national pride and civic duties. NSS at Swami Shraddhanand College collected maati for the Amrit Kalash Yatra, promoting active participation among volunteers and college staff.
4. Fit India Freedom Run 4.0 by NSS at Swami Shraddhanand College on 12th-13th October 2023 promoted fitness and mental well-being.
5. Hosted a seminar with the Undecide Community on decision-making in life with the Youth Collective on October 16th, 2023.



6. On October 19th, 2023, Sakshi NGO conducted a webinar focusing on raising awareness about the Prevention of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act and addressing issues of child sexual abuse and workplace harassment.
7. Khadi Mahotsav 2023 celebrated Khadi's role in India's freedom struggle, emphasizing self-reliance and various benefits. Volunteers pledged to promote Khadi for Atmanirbhar Bharat and enhanced their knowledge through a Khadi quiz.

8. Celebrated Diwali at Alipur Sewa Basti with youth volunteers from NSS, YUVA, and SSNC on November 5th, 2023. They distributed biscuits and diyas and conducted an educational needs survey.
9. National Voters Day: Conducted an online awareness program for volunteers in celebration of National Voters Day, observed on January 25th, 2024.
10. NSS with AIIMS Delhi, organised a successful blood donation camp in Alipur on February 12th, 2024, collecting over 90 units of blood. Volunteers conducted door-to-door mobilization and classroom education, emphasizing the benefits of blood donation.
11. NSS with Sant Nirankari Charitable Foundation, held a seminar on Project Amrit, a water conservation initiative, on February 19th. The event motivated volunteers to join the upcoming Yamuna River cleaning initiative on February 25th, aiming for environmental conservation and community engagement.
12. NSS with FIAPSO India, hosted a webinar titled "Farming Animals and Us" on February 22nd, 2024. It explored animal emotions, and challenges, and advocated for a vegan lifestyle due to its benefits on health, ethics, and the environment.
13. On February 25th, participated in "Project Amrit" for water conservation. Activities included cleaning, tree planting, and a talk by Satguru Mata and Raj Pita on the theme "Swachh Jal, Swachh Mann," highlighting the link between mental clarity, water cleanliness, and environmental health.
14. Participated in a voter awareness program on February 27th. The event featured a speech by Tapan Jha, the State District Election Officer, who elaborated on the significance of voting in democracy and provided a detailed explanation of the voting process, including Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs) and Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT) systems.
15. Celebrated Republic Day and Parakram Diwas on January 28th, 2024, with children from the Azadpur slum community. Activities included games, a drawing competition, and educational sessions about the significance of these days, along with distributing stationery items to the children.
