

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME

The NSS Unit of Swami Shraddhanand College, University of Delhi, has consistently demonstrated its commitment to societal development and community welfare. Through dedicated efforts and active participation in various initiatives, the unit has successfully organized numerous programs aimed at fostering awareness, social responsibility, and civic engagement. These endeavors reflect the unwavering commitment of students to community service, contributing positively to both the college and the surrounding communities. The key activities undertaken by the NSS Unit during the academic year are outlined below:

1. 10-DAY YOGA CAMP (18/04/2024 – 27/04/2024): The NSS Unit successfully organized a 10-day yoga camp within the college campus, promoting physical and mental well-being. The event was highly impactful, encouraging a healthier lifestyle and fostering camaraderie through interactive sessions.

2. SWACHHATA HI SEVA – CLEANLINESS DRIVE (26/09/2024): The NSS Unit of Swami Shraddhanand College, University of Delhi, successfully conducted a cleanliness drive under the "Swachhata Hi Seva (SHS) Campaign" in the adopted village of Alipur. A total of 65 volunteers actively participated, underscoring the significance of collective action in achieving a cleaner and healthier environment.

3. GLOBAL ROTI DAY (20/10/2024): The NSS Unit actively participated in the "Walk for Hunger-Free India" organized by the Vishalakshi Foundation. A total of 36 volunteers joined the walk, carrying and distributing food to the needy along the way, reinforcing the spirit of compassion and social responsibility.

4. EYE CHECK-UP CAMP (24/10/2024 – 25/10/2024): In collaboration with Saksham Indraprastha, North District, the NSS Unit organized a two-day Eye Check-up Camp. On October 24, 2024, the camp was held within the college premises, witnessing enthusiastic participation from students and staff. On October 25, 2024, the mobile van was stationed in the adopted village of Alipur, where more than 100 residents availed themselves of the eye check-up services.



5. CONSTITUTION DAY (25/11/2024): The NSS Unit actively participated in the "Padayatra" organized by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports under the theme "Mera Samvidhan, Mera Swabhiman," commemorating the 75th Constitution Day. Seven volunteers represented the college in this significant initiative, reaffirming their commitment to constitutional values and national pride.

6. PLANTATION DRIVE (11/12/2024): The NSS Unit organized a plantation drive under the theme "Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam," wherein 36 volunteers participated in planting 2,000 trees within the college campus. The event aimed to promote environmental conservation and encouraged participants to dedicate a tree in honor of their mothers.



7. VISIT TO APNA GHAR AASHRAM: A visit to Apna Ghar Aashram, Budhpur, was undertaken by 33 NSS volunteers along with 11 other college students. This visit profoundly impacted the participants, offering them valuable insights into selfless service and compassion as they connected with the elderly residents, referred to as "Prabhu Ji."
