

Different Coloured Dustbins placed at various places in the Campus

1. Management of various types of degradable and non-degradable waste

All types of waste, biodegradable and non-biodegradable, are segregated in the college campus for proper management and disposal. Students are sensitized through various programs such as cleanliness drives and seminars to make them aware of the importance of cleanliness and waste management. The college has the facility of a composting plant where all biodegradable waste is collected and processed. separate bins of different colors are placed in the campus at various places for collecting the waste. The biodegradable cutlery and refreshment boxes are used for serving the eatables during programs and various events organized in the campus. Signboards and guidelines for disposal of different types of solid waste are mentioned properly in the laboratories and other places. Separate dustbins for biodegradable and non-biodegradable waste are placed in the campus. Bio composting and vermicomposting is done for managing biodegradable waste. Separate bins and places are designated for collecting the E waste and recycling paper. E waste and Paper recycling is done on a regular basis with the collaboration of NGO. Liquid waste from the lab is carefully collected and dumped in the pits separately. A large common septic tank is there to collect the waste of sinks from labs, toilets and pantries. Proper guidelines are displayed in labs for managing the Harmful and hazardous waste.







WHAT IS E-WASTE ?

E-waste is the popular name for a large variety of electronics and electronic components that can no longer be used for the purpose for which they were intended.

Batteries: cadmium, copper, and (in older batteries) mercury
Cell phones: antimony, arsenic, beryllium, cadmium, copper, lead, nickel, zinc
Computers and computer monitors: arsenic, cadmium, lead, PCBs
Electronic devices: lead
Fluorescent lamps: mercury
Televisions: arsenic, cadmium, lead, PCBs

WHAT TO DO ? क्या करना है?

- Kindly drop off your e-waste at the nearest Abhyuday Setu drop box.
- Separate packaging material from electronic waste as per safe disposal option.
- Protect the glass surface of the product to avoid breakage.
- Remove all personal and/or confidential information. Easily available data destruction software can "shred" files that could otherwise fall into the wrong hands.
- Check to see if electronic components work before disposing of them. If these components do work, consider donating them to schools, etc., for re-use or repurposing.
- When donating phones remove their SIM cards. Your SIM card identifies you on your provider's network and contains your network authorization data, personal security keys, contact lists and stored text messages etc. Physically destroy the SIM card after removing it from the phone.

THREE STEPS TO ERASE YOUR E-WASTE

- STEP 1: Identify your E-Waste. Follow the Do's and Don'ts manual while segregating your waste.
- STEP 2: Once you have collected the E-Waste you can contact your area co-ordinator to drop your waste at select points near you house/area. (For your information our co-ordinators contact details have been provided for your convenience).
- STEP 3: Our Abhyuday co-ordinators will collect the e-waste from select areas and hand it over to the processing point.
