




Notable Achievement By Faculty Members

13. Research Contributions in Aquatic Animal Health

Assistant Professor Gowri Devi Kommana from the Department of Zoology published a research article on bacterial haemorrhagic septicaemia causing mortality in Indian major carps from Kolleru lake, Andhra Pradesh. The study was published in The Indian Journal of Animal Sciences (October 2025). The research provides valuable insights into disease occurrence in aquaculture systems. It supports improved health management and sustainable fish culture practices.



14. Enhancing Maize Resilience Under Salt Stress



Professor Madhulika Singh, Department of Botany, published a study on the combined role of Piriformospora indica and salicylic acid in improving salt stress tolerance in maize. The study highlights significant improvements in plant growth, photosynthesis, and stress-responsive gene expression under saline conditions. The findings provide sustainable strategies to boost crop resilience and productivity.

15. International Journal Review Contributions

Dr. Ashutosh Kumar Jha, Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce, served as a reviewer for the International Journal of Economics, Finance and Management Sciences (IJEFM), New York, USA. He reviewed two international research papers titled "Strategic Financial Resources: The Antecedent for Superior Performance of Deposit Taking SACCOS in Kiambu County, Kenya" and "Monitoring and Evaluation Communication, Organizational Culture and Performance of Microfinance Institutions in Kenya." The reviews were completed on 25 September 2025 and 04 November 2025 respectively.

16. Contribution to Sustainable Agriculture Research

Professor Madhulika Singh, Department of Botany, published a scholarly work titled "Nano-fertilizers: Unlocking Potential and Addressing Challenges for Sustainable Agriculture." The work is included in the edited volume *Adaptive Agro-Management for Environmental Sustainability* by CRC Press, Taylor & Francis. It emphasizes innovative and sustainable approaches to improve agricultural productivity and environmental health.



17. From Research Insights to National Recognition



Professor Madhulika Singh presented a research poster on the combined role of *Piriformospora indica* and salicylic acid in improving stress tolerance in maize at the National Conference on Fungi for Bharat, University of Delhi (20–22 November 2025).

In recognition of her contributions to mycological research, she was awarded a Certificate of Appreciation at the 52nd Annual Meeting of the Mycological Society of India.
