02. MOU for Installation of Automatic Weather Station (AWS)



The installation of an Automatic Weather Station (AWS) under Mission Mausam, a flagship programme of the Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES), Government of India in Swami Shraddhanand College is being jointly implemented by the Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology (IITM - Pune), India Meteorological Department (IMD), and the National Centre for Medium Range Weather Forecasting (NCMRWF - Noida).

The objective is to strengthen ground-based weather monitoring for disaster management, early warning systems, and climate resilience, particularly for urban areas like Delhi which face challenges from extreme weather events.
